I have news. I can confirm that from early January 2019 I will be Senior [managing] Chaplain to Her Majesty's Prison and Young Offenders Institution Chelmsford (where, famously, Porridge was filmed).

I will be resigning from my hospital post. I will be carrying on in the parish role, though obviously with much reduced availability. In due course I expect to move to deepest Essex, but for a while I will commute from my current flat in Newham (happily against the flow of traffic). I don't have news of my licensing at this point.

I will spare you the whole grizzly story, but say only "it has been a long time coming".

I am aware that this is immersion. I have never worked in a prison before, and prisons are - even by their own modest standards - troubled places just now. But I will say that I felt "called" to this, in no small part because I am so clear I will be relying on God's grace to get the job done. The chaplaincy team is cohesive and committed. (I have, you see, been helping out a bit over recent months.) Credit for this must go to

God, and then the inimitable **James Ridge**, whose shoes I cannot hope to fill and will not try to. I will just do my best. As James insists, it is a pastoral role, at the end of the day, and I've not been too disastrous pastorally over the years.

I crave your prayers or mindfulness during the time of transition.
