Revision of Electoral Roll 2019

The Electoral Roll is a sort of official membership of an Anglican church. On an official level, being on the Electoral Roll gives you the right to vote at our Annual Parochial Church Meeting, mainly for the PCC, as well as the right to use our church for baptisms, marriages and funerals. The number on the electoral role is used to decide the number of representatives on Deanery Synod (the next level up in church organisation) .

However, more importantly, unofficially, being on the Electoral Roll is a declaration of your desire to belong to our church family and partner with us in our church's mission. It therefore gives you a voice in shaping our priorities and enables you to support the ministries of our church.

Every six years we are required by the Church of England to "start again", that is, delete everyone from the Electoral Roll and ask people to sign up again.

It is easy to sign up for the Electoral Roll, simply read and fill in the Electoral roll form and return it to Jeremy or Tony **before 21st April**.

Our next APCM will be held on **Sunday April 28th** and the new electoral role should be compiled before this date.
