attached to the messuage.

WINTERTON PAR/8/2 Deedpoll of grant by way of trust 26 May 1544

Peter Morley of Winterton to Henry Ashewyn and Henry Bellhered.

Property: three quarters of a bovate of arable, meadow and pasture usually called Foxley Landes, held of the manor of Kirton Lindsey for an annual payment of 5 shillings. The grantees are to hold the land in trust for the granter for life and offerwards for

the grantor for life and afterwards for

Anthony Holland and his heirs, failing whom for Peter Holland and his heirs, failing whom the grantor's sister Elizabeth and her heirs.

Signed and sealed by grantor.

On the dorse is an extract from the Kirton court rolls of a bargain and sale of the same property by James Poppelwell to John Morley.
