Tax claimed by Winterton PCC

- Winterton PCC will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.

- The Government will pay to Winterton PCC an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.
