All Saints has just donated £810 in total to nine different charities.

For many years All Saints' Church in Winterton has had a policy of donating 10% of all money raised each year through fund-raising to other charities. A range of fund-raising activities takes place including monthly waste paper collections, regular coffee mornings, annual garden party, highly successful jazz concerts, many other choir and brass band concerts, hobbies day and sales of items such as second hand books. A large number of people in Winterton help to organise these activities.

The charities chosen by All Saints are a mix of local, national and international, some Christian and some not. The amount of money donated each year depends on how successful fund-raising activities have been in the previous 12 months.

The Parochial Church Council at All Saints met in January 2011 and agreed to donate £810 in total and that this year it should be split between: Help for Heroes; Lindsey Lodge Hospice; British Red Cross; Cornerstone Community Coffee Shop [in Winterton]; USPG Anglicans in World Mission; Salvation Army; Anti-Poverty Group [in Scunthorpe]; UK Friends of Mengo [a hospital in Uganda]; Christian Aid.
