

ALL SAINTS' CHURCH WINTERTON

Major Conservation and Development Project

'All Saints - the story it tells of Winterton'

Aim of capital works - to carry out essential repairs & improve access to amenities within the building - to meet a wider variety of community needs and become a focus for community heritage

Start date - Summer 2014 [Phase 1]

Roof, fabric & window repairs, new rainwater goods, internal archaeology, repainting tower clock face

To be followed by -

- New level floor, heating, lighting, sound & security systems, seating & storage. Internal repairs & decoration
- Creation of areas for display, interpretation and study of Winterton's heritage
- Conservation of church archives and artefacts
- New extension on north side for kitchen & toilets
- Churchyard improvements
- Capital works completion date: Summer 2015
- Programme of new uses & activities planned for church on completion



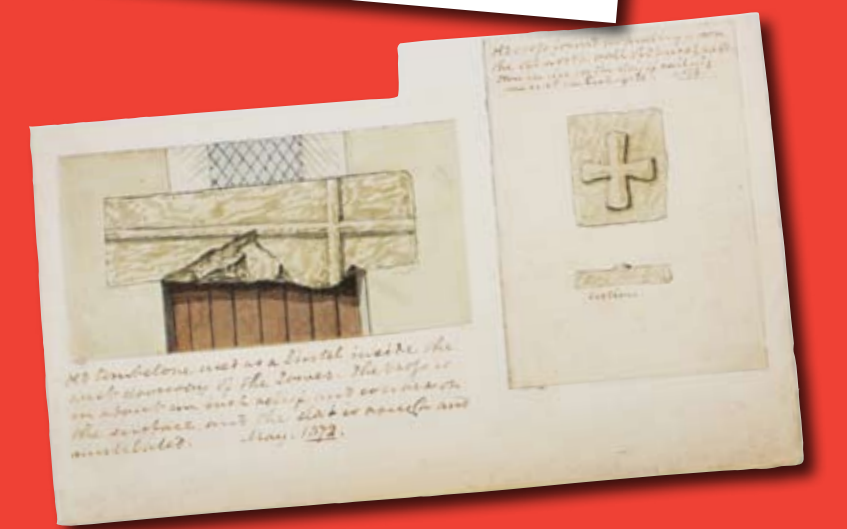
Total project cost - including capital works, conservation and activity programme - over £1million
