The PCC's of the Billingborough Group have agreed that their preference for Baptism/Christening is during the main Sunday Service in the Billingborough Group of Churches, however, they understand that this is not always possible and have allowed for a baptism/christening to take place after the service. Timings outside these would need to be agreed on an individual case-by-case basis with the Priest-in-Charge and do not represent a precedent for any other Baptism /Christening

The church does not charge any fee for baptism but we invite you to consider giving a donation in the collection plate on the day or separately by cheque/bank transfer (*details from the parish priest*) for the upkeep of the church in order that we can continue to provide services such as this as well as the many other services and events which take place in our parish churches.
