

Invitation to sponsor a seat at All Saints, Winterton

You are invited to sponsor one of the new seats installed at All Saints.

What are the new seats like?



There are a range of chairs, armchairs, benches and folding chairs similar to those in the photos below. They are all constructed in the UK mostly of solid oak with seagrass seat panels.

There are a few armchairs and benches. Most of the seats are solid chairs or folding chairs. There are metal linkages to allow the seats to be fitted together in rows. In all 236 new seats have been delivered.



What does sponsorship involve?

For a minimum donation of £100 you can sponsor a chair. Donations we have received vary between £100 and £1,000 per seat. You will not have bought the seat for £100 as they cost much more. But by sponsoring a large part of the cost you will be entitled to have a brass plaque fixed to the chair. Unfortunately all the armchairs and benches have already been sponsored. There are still solid and folding chairs available.

If you are a UK tax-payer [income or capital gains tax] and you would like to gift-aid your donation, All Saints will get back £25 tax on top of your £100 donation at no extra cost to you. This will boost the fund-raising for our re-ordering project even more. Please consider this if this applies to you.

What wording can go on the plaque?

The wording will need to be simple as the plaque is small. Some examples are shown here.



The plaque does not have to be in

memory of a deceased relative or friend. It can simply mark the donation made by you.

You can suggest suitable wording for your plaque.

Who can be involved in this sponsorship scheme?

Anyone who is interested can sponsor a seat whether or not they attend All Saints' Church and whether or not they live in Winterton. This is a chance for everyone who wants to help secure the future of All Saints for our community.

Similarly the name on the plaque does not have to be a current or former resident of Winterton.

How many seats can be sponsored?

You can sponsor as many seats as you wish. We have 236 in the church so there is the chance for many people to be involved. Please spread the word about this scheme. If we could get a plaque on every new seat we could raise a minimum of £23,600 [even more with Gift Aid]. It would make a huge difference to the funding we still need!
